Instructions

- Designated Caregivers are not required to complete a new criminal history records check when they apply to renew their registry identification card for the Therapeutic Cannabis Program. Instead, Designated Caregivers must complete and submit this "Attestation of No Felony Conviction" form with their renewal application.
- If there has been a lapse in a Designated Caregiver's registration for the Therapeutic Cannabis Program (for example, if the registry identification card expires before the renewal materials are submitted to the Program), the Designated Caregiver must complete a new state and federal criminal history records check.
